

WKU Speech-Language Pathology Graduate Program Prerequisite Information

Eight Speech Prerequisites:

1. CD 405 – Applied Phonetics
2. CD 481 - Speech and Language Development
3. CD 485 – Introduction to Assessment in Communication Disorders
4. CD 484 - Speech Anatomy and Physiology
5. CD 482 – Audiology
6. CD 483 – Introduction to Disorders of Articulation and Phonology
7. CD 486 - Language Disorders
8. CD 347 - Science of Speech and Hearing

Additionally, ASHA requires four basic sciences:

1. **Biological Science**
Examples include: Intro to General Biology, Human Biology, Ecology, Plant Biology, Human Anatomy and Physiology (not the same as Speech A&P), Animal Biology, Cell Biology, Microbiology, or CLEP: Natural Science
2. **Statistics:**
Must be a Statistics course – if course does not specifically have “statistics” in the name a syllabus will be required for review
3. **Social Science**
Examples include: Psychology, Sociology, Anthropology, Human Geography, Gerontology, CLEP: Psychology
4. **Physical Science**
Physics, Chemistry, CLEP: Chemistry
